

**NEW ENGLAND INTERCOLLEGIATE GOLF ASSOCIATION
GORDON MC CULLOUGH MEMORIAL AWARD (COACHES AWARD)**

The NEIGA will honor each year the coach who demonstrates the criteria established in 1992 for recognition of outstanding service to New England college golf as the “**New England Coach Honoree**”.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The New England Coach “Honoree” must:

- (a) be a member in good standing with NEIGA and NCAA
- (b) personify management, sportsmanship, ethics, and comradeship of fellow coaches
- (c) have coached college golf for a minimum of 10 years (see list of eligible coaches below)
- (d) make over-all contributions to N.E. golf including, instruction to junior golf and coaching, hosting tournaments, serving on committees
- (e) maintain a positive relationship with players, including dress, behavior, rapport
- (f) maintain accurate records of players’ performance and academic standing
- (g) demonstrate good coaching skills on and off the golf course
- (h) demonstrate cooperation with NEIGA Executive Committee and Executive Director
- (i) be knowledgeable of USGA, NCAA, NEIGA rules and regulations
- (j) contribute to the community on behalf of collegiate golf
